## Analysis of Speed Indicator Device (SID) data for December 2023 \& January 2024

The SID was located on Bluntisham Road near the "Colne" sign, facing towards Bluntisham, for 52 days between November $30^{\text {th }} 2023$ \& January $21^{\text {st }} 2024$. (The SID collects data not only from approaching vehicles but also from those departing in the opposite direction; in the case of departing vehicles the speed is not displayed to the driver.)

Over the 52 day period, $31 \%$ of all vehicles were recorded exceeding the 30 mph speed limit. The average speed was 29 mph with $15 \%$ of vehicles travelling at over 32 mph . These figures are a significant improvement on those recorded at the same location in January to March 2023 when almost $40 \%$ of vehicles exceeded the limit.

## Vehicles approaching from Bluntisham

$31 \%$ of vehicles were recorded as travelling in excess of the 30 mph limit with almost one in six (15\%) recorded travelling at a speed greater than 33 mph . The average speed was 29 mph .

These figures represent a significant improvement on those from January to March 2023 at the same location when $36 \%$ of vehicles were recorded as exceeding the limit.

The diagram, below, shows the distribution of vehicle speeds arriving from Bluntisham:


## Vehicles departing towards Bluntisham

(The speed of vehicles travelling in this direction is not displayed to the driver and so the presence of the SID is likely to be less of a deterrent.)
$32 \%$ of all vehicles were travelling in excess of the 30 mph limit with almost one in six exceeding 33 mph . The average speed was 28 mph .

These figures show a significant improvement over those from January to March 2023 at the same location.
